Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
3. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
4. Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.
5. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

NOTE:

1.0 DELIVERY TIMING: Suppliers will be given necessary permission to enter into the Industrial Area or Company's other operating areas to deliver the material as per timings given below:-

a) Monday to Friday:

(i) Slot-1 : **08.00 AM to 10.00 AM**

(ii) Slot-2 : **12.30 PM to 02.00 PM**

b) Saturday : **08.00 AM to 10.00 AM**

Note: No delivery shall be made on Sunday / National Holidays

3.0 The tender has been floated in GeM portal under Single Stage Two Bid System. Therefore, bidder must not disclose their prices in their technical offer. The technical bid shall contain all techno-commercial details except the prices/costs. Bidder must note that disclosure of price in technical bids shall lead to rejection of the offer.

1.2 NOTES TO BIDDER REGARDING EXPERIENCE CRITERIA

1.2.1 The following documentary evidences to substantiate above experience records (1.1) of the Bidder must be submitted along with the technical bid, failing which the Bid shall be treated as incomplete and rejected:

(a) Copy of Purchase order(s)/contract(s) awarded by Client(s)

(b) Any one or combination of the following documents that confirms the successful execution of each of the purchase order(s) / contract(s) :-

Copy of Consignee delivery receipts/challans

OR

Copy of Tax Invoice/Excise Gate Pass issued under relevant Act/rules

OR

Copy of Commercial Invoice/Payment Certificate

Note: Regarding supply experience

a) The purchase order date need not be within 5 (five) years preceding original bid closing date of this tender. However, the execution of supply should be within 5 (five) years preceding original bid closing date of this tender.

b) Satisfactory supply report (if submitted) should be issued on client's official letterhead with signature and stamp.

The bidder must have experience of successfully executing at least 01 (One) purchase order of value of minimum Rs. 36.05 Lakhs for supplying item with similar item either by themselves or through their authorized agent/dealer / distributor to any E&P company, State / Central PSUs or State / Central Govt. Dept. of India or any other Public Limited Company, in last 5 years reckoned from the original bid closing date.

Similar Items means: -

"Diesel engine driven or Electric Motor driven Screw Air Compressor Package with minimum guaranteed free air delivery of 40 CFM and minimum working pressure of 12.0 kg/cm²"

(ii). In case the Bidder is an OEM approved authorized Dealer or Distributor:

The bidder should have the experience of successfully executing a single order for at least 05 (Five) nos. of similar item to any E&P company, State / Central PSUs or State / Central Govt. Dept. of India or any other Public Limited Company, in last 5 years reckoned from the original bid closing date.

OR

The bidder must have experience of successfully executing at least 01 (One) purchase order of value of minimum Rs. 36.05 Lakhs for supplying similar item to any E&P company, State / Central PSUs or State / Central Govt. Dept. of India or any other Public Limited Company, in last 5 years reckoned from the original bid closing date.

Similar Items means: -

"Diesel engine driven or Electric Motor driven Screw Air Compressor Package with minimum guaranteed free air delivery of 40 CFM and minimum working pressure of 12.0 kg/cm²"

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6. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. [Click here to view the file](#)

Disclaimer

Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
